RESOLUTION NO. 668-19**

BUDGET AMENDMENT #02

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 budget for the St. Lucie County Fire District, the Capital Improvement Revenue Bond, Series 2017 was approved by the Board to purchase fire and ambulance vehicles, fire and ambulance equipment; and other lifesaving equipment; the final Draws No. 4 through No. 7 are to fund the construction of Fire Station #5, and purchase the following: six rescue vehicles, Self Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment, and a water tanker apparatus. This revised resolution is to amend Resolution No. 665-19 for a Scrivener Error.

WHEREAS, Section 189.418(6) (c), Florida Statutes, requires the St. Lucie County Fire District to adopt a resolution to amend the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the St. Lucie County Fire District, in meeting assembled this 20th day of February, 2019, these funds are hereby appropriated and the 2018-2019 budget for the St. Lucie County Fire District is hereby amended as follows:




