**WHEREAS**, these Telecommunicators are the vital link to those calling for help and to firefighters and paramedics and monitor emergency personnel's activities by radio and telephone, and provide them with life saving information to ensure their safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the safety of SLCFD firefighters and paramedics is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained by all Telecommunicators from the citizens who telephone the St. Lucie County Fire Emergency Operations Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the Telecommunicators of the St. Lucie County Fire District Emergency Communications Center have contributed significantly to the suppression of fire and the treatment of patients in life threatening situations; and

**WHEREAS**, each Telecommunicator, who is the unseen individual providing a calm voice when emergencies arise, has exhibited compassion, empathy, and professionalism while keeping our community and its citizens safe.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the St. Lucie County Fire District does hereby proclaim that the week of April 10-16, 2022, be known as follows:

**“NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK,”**

and commend the St. Lucie County Fire District Telecommunicators for their efforts on behalf of St. Lucie County and its citizens.
