



**ST. LUCIE COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT
RESOLUTION NO. 732-22**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE
ST. LUCIE COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT OF ST. LUCIE COUNTY,
FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 – 2023 AND PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the St. Lucie County Fire District, of St. Lucie County, Florida, has made the following determination:

1. On September 7, 2022, after TRIM notices were mailed to all property owners pursuant to Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, the Board of Commissioners for the St. Lucie County Fire District held a public hearing to consider adopting the Tentative Millage. Following the public hearing, as required by Florida Statute 200.065, the Board adopted the fiscal year 2022-2023 tentative millage rate; and
2. On September 21, 2022, after notice was published in the Tribune on September 16, 2022, the Board held a Public Hearing and Adopted the Final Millage for the fiscal year 2022-2023; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within St. Lucie County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the St. Lucie County Fire District as \$30,461,282,290.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the St. Lucie County Fire District of St. Lucie County, Florida, that:

1. The FY 2022-2023 final operating millage rate for the St. Lucie County Fire District is hereby adopted at 3.0000 mills which is higher than the rolled-back rate of 2.6276 as computed pursuant to Section 200.065(1), Florida Statutes by 14.17%.
2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
