SUBJECT: Interlocal Cost Share Agreement between The St. Lucie County Fire District and The City Of Port St. Lucie for the Traffic Signalization Station 20 SW Village Parkway

Background:

On September 18, 2024, the Fire Board of Commissioners approved the project agreement for the traffic signal at SW Village Parkway, authorizing the transition from a span wire design to a full mast arm signal. This upgrade is critical to improving traffic control and safety at the intersection, particularly in light of the City of Port Saint Lucie's development of the Stars and Stripes Park, located directly across from Fire Station No. 20. The anticipated increase in traffic volume from park visitors underscores the need for this enhancement to ensure effective emergency vehicle access.

As part of this approval, the Fire Board also authorized the Fire District to enter into negotiations with the City of Port Saint Lucie for a cost-sharing agreement to reimburse the Fire District for a portion of the project expenses. Under the Interlocal Cost Share Agreement, the City of Port St. Lucie will reimburse the Fire District for the cost differential between the original span wire design and the upgraded mast arm signal design. The cost of the original span wire design is estimated at \$327,877.00, with the **City committed to reimbursing the Fire District up to \$315,624.00** for the additional costs incurred for the mast arm upgrade. This reimbursement significantly offsets the project's financial impact on the Fire District.

Previous Action:

- September 18, 2024 – Approval of Project Agreement for Traffic Signal SW Village Parkway

Financial Impact:

The Fire District will receive a net \$315,624.00 reimbursement from The City of Port St. Lucie.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of the Interlocal Cost Share Agreement between the St. Lucie County Fire District and the City of Port St. Lucie.
