

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO SOLE SOURCE

### **Synopsis:**

In accordance with the St. Lucie County Fire District's Procurement Policy and Procedure Manual. The St. Lucie County Fire District (SLCFD) intends to award a sole source contract to Taylor'd Systems, LLC. SLCFD intends to purchase the Taylor'd Prop, a compact training system with an approximate footprint of 12' x 8' x 8'6", designed to support multiple firefighter training evolutions in one integrated unit.

### **Reason for Sole Source:**

SLCFD has determined that Taylor'd Systems, LLC is the only known vendor able to provide this specific integrated prop configuration, with the required combination of features and training evolutions in a single system footprint suitable for SLCFD's operational training needs.

This purchase is intended to support consistent, repeatable, and standardized training for firefighter operations, including forcible entry, ventilation, ladder operations, Mayday/RIT-related skills, and rescue-related evolutions.

### **Response Information:**

Interested parties may identify their interest and capability to respond to this requirement. This notice of intent is not a request for competitive proposals; however, all responses received within 3 days of publication of this notice will be considered by SLCFD. A determination by SLCFD not to compete this proposed contract based upon responses to this notice is solely within the discretion of SLCFD. Information received will normally be considered solely for the purpose of determining whether to conduct a competitive procurement.

### **Submission Information:**

### **Additional Information:**

All responses must be in writing and must provide clear and concise documentation indicating your firm's capability to provide the requested services. Telephone requests will not be honored. All responses should include the notice number in the subject line of the email.
